The New York City Department of Health Lead Poisoning Prevention Program received a report from the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development regarding lead based paint violations issued at the address listed above. The report also indicated that TIMOTHY NICKERSON, born on June 11, 2006, lives at that address.

Young children may be at risk of being lead poisoned from leaded dust and paint chips. The only way to know if a child has lead poisoning is through a blood lead test

- **Please contact this child's doctor to schedule a venous blood lead test immediately and a second test immediately after the lead paint repairs are completed.**
- **If there are other young children who live or spend time at this address, they may also need blood lead tests. Please contact their medical providers also.**
- **Read the enclosed brochure for information on lead poisoning prevention.**

If you have questions about lead poisoning or need help arranging a follow-up blood lead test, please call 311.
